



SNAPSHOT OF CURRENT PRESENTER INTENT FOR 2020-22

A poll of PAC Australia presenter members have indicated their current response to programming in 2020/21.

<i>Which of the below BEST DESCRIBES how you have shifted 2020 programming in response to COVID-19:</i>	
16%	2020 performances have been CANCELLED and we are moving forward with 2021 planning that was already underway
9%	2020 performances have been CANCELLED and we are NOT in a position to actively pursue programming for 2021 at the present time
60%	We've RESCHEDULED the majority of performances into 2021 and are ALSO still planning to stage some or all of the performances that were already programmed for 2021
14%	We've RESCHEDULED the majority of performances into 2021 and have therefore abandoned previous plans for 2021

We have specifically not polled on the remaining activity in 2020 that is still planned to proceed as yet, given the fluidity of the current situation.

We also asked about whether presenters are looking to 2022 programming:

<i>"We are, or soon will be, looking at programming for 2022":</i>	
Yes	58%
No	28%
Other	14%

Comments for "Other" responses included:

<i>We're close to having direction on budget moving forward which will determine what we can do</i>
<i>Our Council prefers programming 12 - 18 months in advance</i>
<i>Not too sure as yet. Need to gauge the capacity for those in discussion for 2021 to move to 2022 if the program maxes out</i>
<i>Some organisational change will effect 2022 decision making</i>
<i>Will not be in a position to look at 2022 until at least July/August.</i>
<i>Yes, once our capacity has been established</i>
